MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

On behalf of the Board of Directors and the people of Poovanthoppu, thank you for joining us for this exciting event. The Salt Street Foundation has been an amazing collaboration of talented people and a very special community. Together, the people of Ulmstead and our friends and neighbors in the larger community have made our vision a reality.

Since our first Magic on the Magothy event last year, we have sent over \$40,000 to the village of Poovanthoppu, India. With this money we have:

- Constructed a ***multipurpose community center*** which is being used as a meeting house, storm shelter, health clinic and school.
- Installed ***wells*** to provide clean drinking water for the first time.
- Provided ***health care*** in the village in biweekly clinics
- Provided ***comprehensive community health training*** to a group of women who now provide first line care in the village.
- Developed a ***maternal and child care program***.
- Started a ***nutrition and health awareness program***.
- Developed a ***preschool program*** and a ***bridge school*** to help older kids to return to school.

Tonight, we are here to raise money for the second phase of the project. With the help of the Catholic Health Association of India, we will continue the work now in progress, with the ultimate goal of helping the people of Poovanthoppu achieve self sufficiency. The specific goals of this phase of the project are to:

- Provide ***sustainable livelihood opportunities***, including training programs for rope making and in the preparation of iodized salt.
- Improve the ***health status*** of the people, with continued emphasis on maternal and childcare and nutrition, and a new focus on facilitating access to tertiary care.
- Continue to ***educate and empower*** the people to enable them to work toward improved quality of life and economic self-sufficiency.

Many thanks to all of our generous sponsors and donors, to the Salt Street team for all your dedication to this cause over the last twenty months, and to all who have contributed their time and energy to bring this night together. We are especially grateful to our co-chairs, Terry Cooch and Lisa Chamberlain, without whom none of this would have happened.

*The winner is the highest correct bidder at the time the bid sheet is removed by the auction staff.

- The Salt Street Foundation makes no warranties or representations of any kind regarding any item or service sold.
- Values on some items being auctioned are estimates only and have been set by the donor. Values are not guaranteed for tax purposes or fair market value.
- Check out will begin at the conclusion of the silent auction. Buyers must pay full purchase price by cash or check to the cashier by the close of the auction, and remove the item before leaving.
- All sales are final; all items are sold “as is”, no exchanges, refunds or credits will be made.
- It is the buyer’s responsibility to contact the donor to arrange fulfillment of all contracts. Unless otherwise specified, all auctioned items must be used within one year from the date of the auction. Dates and times to be arranged by the donor and the buyer for their mutual convenience.
- **Bids are in \$10 increments. If the final bid is not in the appropriate increment, the previous bid will prevail.**
- All bids are binding. The committee reserves the right to withdraw any item, which, in its opinion, fails to receive an adequate bid.
- In the event that a bid sheet is completely filled, or intense bidding is in progress at the close of the silent auction, the item may be converted to a live auction.

Live Auction
